

# THE GNOMES OF DOC HOLLOW

## GNOMES OF DOC HOLLOW - DH 1431 thru DH 1442.

**Materials Needed:** Greenware, Various Brushes, Cleaning Tools, Music Box & Turntable, Weathered Wood Crackle, Brush-on Glitter, Silver, Gold, Red, Blue & Clear, Chalk for Blushing Cheeks, Doc's Glue SP5.

**Doc Holiday Colors:** DH-8 Black, DH-29 White, DH-39 Bright Blue, DH-16 Flaxen Yellow, DH-12 Leather Brown, DH-32 Christmas Red, DH-3 True Orange, DH-10 Mustard, DH-31 Leaf Green, DH-37 Cream, DH-25 Toast, DH-38 Grass Green, DH-9 Real Brown, DH-18 Medium Brown, DH-36 Navy Blue, DH-15 Mystic Purple, DH-11 Beige, DH-30 Country Blue, DH-45 Shadow Green, DH-19 Light Grey, DH-27 Midnight Blue, DH-42 Dark Grey, DH-48 Gold, DH-47 Silver, DH-40 Turquoise, DH-43 Teal, DH-24 Terra Cotta, DH-1 Daffodil, AT-4 Red Brown, FT1 Fingertip Silver, FT2 Fingertip Gold.

**\*Note:** All skin on the gnomes is basecoated Beige, then antiqued with Red Brown Translucent. All eyes are painted with Leaf Green iris' and Black pupils. Lips are painted with a thin wash of Leather Brown. Cheeks are "blushed" with Chalk. Eyebrows are painted with individual's hair color.

### DH 1431 CHOPPER

**Step 1:** Basecoat belly with Bright Blue. Apply 1 coat of Weathered Wood over belly. Let dry. Carefully brush on 1 coat of Flaxen Yellow over the Weathered Wood, being careful not to overlap brush strokes. Let dry thoroughly.

**Step 2:** Basecoat all remaining areas Black. Drybrush Chopper body Leather Brown. Drybrush body again with Christmas Red. Add highlights to body with True Orange, then Mustard. (Drybrush Mustard heavily around the face and ears.) Shade the sides of belly and between sections with True Orange wash. Shade around the sections of the head with a Christmas Red wash. Shade around muscles, ears, toes, etc. with a Black wash.

**Step 3:** Paint eyes Leaf Green, with Black pupils. Paint toenails Cream, shade tops with a Toast wash. Paint a line of Red Brush-on Glitter along sides of belly.

**Step 4:** Drybrush grass with Grass Green, highlight lightly with Mustard.

**Step 5:** Paint belt buckle with Silver Brush-on Glitter.

### DH 1438 HARLEY & DH 1439 SCOOTER

**Step 1:** Basecoat all areas, except skin, with Black. Drybrush hair with Real Brown; drybrush highlights on hair with Toast, then very lightly with Mustard.

**Step 2:** Drybrush pants with Butter Cream. Shade around waist & boots with a wash of Medium Brown. Drybrush boots Medium Brown; shade around tops & creases with a Real Brown wash. Drybrush Harley's shirt & hat with Navy Blue. Drybrush Scooter's shirt & hat Mystic Purple. Shade folds & creases of both shirt & Black wash.

### DH 1437 TENDER & MUFFIN

**Step 1:** Basecoat all areas, except skin Black. Drybrush hair & beard with Real Brown, drybrush highlights on hair with Toast. Drybrush pants Medium Brown; highlight with Beige. Drybrush boots & belt with Leather Brown. Drybrush shirt & hat Country Blue; add a little White to your brush and drybrush highlights on edges of shirt & hat.

**Step 2:** Drybrush all remaining areas, except Muffin's belly, Real Brown. Add Medium Brown to your brush and drybrush highlights on ground and tree branch & stump; add a little Sand to your brush and highlight again.

Paint the shirt and glasses White. Paint the rims of glasses Gold.

**Step 2:** Drybrush all remaining areas Real Brown. Paint tree and ground as directed for King & Queen. Drybrush pants Leather Brown. Drybrush clipboard Flaxen Yellow. Apply a wash of Toast over clipboard to make it look old. Paint top of clipboard Silver; then paint it with Silver Brush-on Glitter. Paint "figures" on paper. Paint jacket button with Red Brush-on Glitter. Use Rub-on Silver on dimes, quarters & nickels; use rub on Gold on pennies.

### DH 1441 DOC

**Step 1:** Paint beard and hair Light Grey. Antique with Red Brown Translucent. Drybrush with Light Grey, then White. Basecoat all remaining areas Black.

**Step 2:** Drybrush ground and leaves as directed for Queen & King. Drybrush staff Real Brown; highlight with Sand. Paint star with Gold Brush-on Glitter. Paint design on gown using White and Silver Brush-on Glitter.

### DH 1432 MISS PENNY

**Step 1:** Basecoat hair Light Grey. Basecoat teeth and wings White. Antique the above areas with Red Brown Translucent. Drybrush hair with Light Grey. Drybrush teeth Cream; shade around face and teeth with a Medium Brown wash. Shade the wings with washes of Mystic Purple and Turquoise. Basecoat all remaining areas Black.

**Step 2:** Drybrush the dress and hat Teal. Add Turquoise to your brush and lighten and highlight the dress and hat. Shade the folds and creases of dress with a Teal wash. Paint the shoe Teal. Paint the ground area as directed for King & Queen. Apply Rub-on Silver on the coins. Paint the flowers Mystic Purple and the leaves Grass Green. Paint a pattern on dress with Mystic Purple and Silver Brush-on Glitter. Paint a band of Silver Brush-on Glitter on hat. Paint clear Brush-on Glitter on wings.

### DH 1433 TOM FOOLL & DH 1442 BASE

**Step 1:** Basecoat all areas, except skin, Black. Drybrush shoes, hat, vest and handle of clown Bright Blue. Drybrush all remaining areas Real Brown.

**Step 2:** Drybrush hair Leather Brown; highlight lightly with Terra Cotta. Drybrush face of clown Flaxen Yellow; shade with a wash of Toast. Drybrush pants and sleeves Terra Cotta; drybrush again with True Orange. Shade around waist, feet and arms with a Christmas Red wash. Paint bands on sleeve and one ribbon on clown Bright Blue. Paint clown's hat, buttons and one ribbon on clown Christmas Red. Paint remaining clown ribbon Daffodil. Paint trim around neck and sleeves White, with Christmas Red detail. Paint cross-hatch pattern on vest with Daffodil. Paint bells on hat with Gold Brush-on Glitter on Bright Blue ribbon; paint Clear Brush-on Glitter on Daffodil ribbon.

**Step 3:** Drybrush ground, tree and leaf areas as directed for Queen & King.

**Step 4:** Glue music: box to base and turntable to Tom Fooll's base with Doc's Glue and assemble.

## THE GNOMES OF DOC HOLLOW

**DH 1434 King Louie** - In the industrious land of Doc Hollow, King Louie was the kind leader and decreed that all in his kingdom would be happy.

**DH 1435 Queen Serena** - Queen of Doc Hollow, she provides gracious leadership to the gnome populus and the King's court.

**DH 1441 Doc** - The wizard of Doc Hollow. Doc was regarded as "All Knowing" by the population.

**DH 1437 Tender & Muffin** - Tender, the dragon keeper of Doc Hollow, loved dragons and raised them from hatchlings. Muffin, the cute and adorable baby.

**DH 1438 Harley** - As the dragon rider, Harley was seen as brave by the inhabitants and loved to give rides to the children.

**DH 1439 Scooter** - A gnome youngster who loved to ride the dragons.

**DH 1431 Chopper** - The prize dragon of Doc Hollow because he loved to give rides to the children.

**DH 1433 Tom Fooll** - The jester of the King's court. He keeps all amused by his foolish antics.

**DH 1440 Counter** - The collector of all valuable possessions of Doc Hollow. Counter kept precise count.

**DH 1432 Miss Penny** - The Tooth Fairy of Doc Hollow, loved children and provided rewards for lost teeth.

**DH 1436 Sir Guy** - The warrior knight to the King's court, protector of the land of Doc Hollow.

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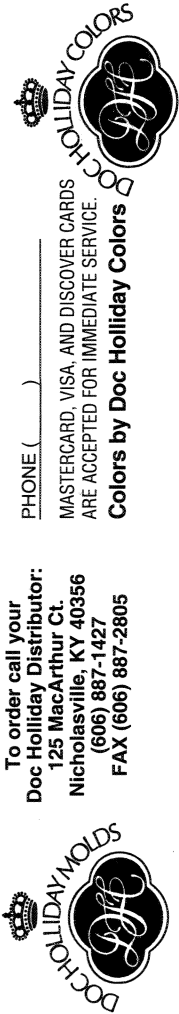
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
