

## DH 1449 KILLER WHALE

**Materials Needed:** Greenware, Various Brushes, Airbrush, Matte Spray, Sponge.

**Ceramicchrome Opaque Underglazes and Glazes:** #131 White, #90 Cobalt Black, #111 Marine Blue, #003 Transparent Gloss Glaze.

**Step 1:** Clean greenware with cleaning tools.

**Step 2:** White Underglazes to White part of whale. Paint water with #131 White.

**Step 3:** Paint #90 Black areas of whale. Put 3 good coats of each color on.

**Step 4:** Paint #131 White line on whale's eyes.

**Step 5:** Fire to Cone 03.

**Step 6:** Antique water with #111 Marine Blue underglaze and wipe off with sponge, leaving color in shaded areas.

**Step 7:** Put 2 coats of #003 Transparent Gloss Glaze.

**Step 8:** Fire to Cone 05.

## DH 1450 DOLPHINS

**Materials Needed:** Greenware, Various Brushes, Airbrush, Matte Spray, Sponge.

**Ceramicchrome Opaque Underglazes and Glazes:** #92 Light Grey, #90 Black, #254 Copenhagen Blue Ice.

**Step 1:** Clean greenware with cleaning tool.

**Step 2:** Airbrush #92 Light Grey to dolphins.

**Step 3:** Add 2 drops of #90 Black to #92 Light Grey and airbrush back areas of dolphins.

**Step 4:** Paint eyes and air holes #90 Black.

**Step 5:** Fire to Cone 03.

**Step 6:** Apply 2 coats of #254 Copenhagen Blue Ice to dolphins and Fire at Cone 05.

**Step 7:** Paint base same as sea-lion base.

## DH 1451 PUFFIN

**Materials Needed:** Greenware, Various Brushes, Matte Spray.

**Doc Holiday Colors:** DH-8 Black, DH-29 White, DH-30 Country Blue, DH-26 Lexington Green, DH-22 Christmas Red, DH-28 Rust, DH-10 Mustard, DH-37 Cream, DH-25 Toast, DH-19 Light Grey.

**Step 1:** Paint around eyes and front of bird White. Paint beak and feet Mustard. Apply a heavy wash of Rust to feet & beak. Paint around eyes Christmas Red. Paint Mustard lines with White and Black on either side on beak. (Refer to photo for placement of colors.) Paint Black pupils with White highlight.

**Step 2:** Paint remaining parts of bird & beak Black. "Feather" the Black into the White on sides of bird. Shade where Black meets White with a Black wash.

**Step 3:** Basecoat rocks and fish Black. Drybrush rocks Light Grey. Shade rocks with thin washes of Toast, Country Blue and Black.

**Step 4:** Drybrush upper part of fish Lexington Green; drybrush again lightly with Teal. Drybrush lower part of fish, ends of fins, around mouth, and end of tail with White. Paint eyes Mustard with Black pupils.

## DH 1452 SEA TURTLE

**Materials Needed:** Greenware, Various Brushes, Airbrush, Matte Spray.

**Doc Holiday Colors:** DH-16 Flaxon Yellow, DH-26 Lexington Green, DH-38 Grass Green, DH-25 Toast, DH-8 Black, DH-10 Mustard, AT-1 Black Antiquing.

**Step 1:** Clean greenware and fire to cone 03.

**Step 2:** Airbrush turtle and base Flaxon Yellow.

**Step 3:** Airbrush shell and turtle Lexington Green, over that, Grass Green.

**Step 4:** Airbrush Toast to turtle shell and turtle to highlight areas.

**Step 5:** Airbrush Black to shade areas on shell.

**Step 6:** Antique turtle Black.

**Step 7:** Drybrush skin on turtle Flaxon Yellow. Outline crevices and lines on turtle's feet with Flaxon Yellow.

**Step 8:** Paint eyes with Mustard and pupils Black.

**Step 9:** Paint base and coral same as the Sea Lion base.

**Step 10:** Spray with Matte Spray Sealer.

## DH 1453 SEA LION

**Materials Needed:** Greenware, Various Brushes, Airbrush, Matte Spray.

**Ceramicchrome Opaque Underglazes & Glazes:** #137 Persimmon, #128 Teakwood, #T12 Black, #D37 Sierra Sand, #D23 Black, #003 Gloss Glaze, Mother of Pearl.

**Doc Holiday Colors:** DH-21 Sand, DH-30 Country Blue, DH-25 Toast, DH-12 Leather Brown, DH-37 Cream, DH-3 True Orange, DH-26 Lexington Green, AT3 True Brown, DH-20 Skyblue, DH-13 Petal Pink.

**Step 1:** Clean greenware with cleaning tools.

**Step 2:** Use air-gun and basecoat sea lion with Opaque underglaze #137. You need to mix 1/2 color and 1/2 water to thin. If you air-gun clogs with paint, you need to add more water.

**Step 3:** Airbrush #128 (1/2 color & 1/2 water) to sea lion leaving highlighted areas sprayed lightly. Spray heavy on shaded areas.

**Step 4:** Use #T12 to shade dark areas.

**Step 5:** Paint eyes with #D37 and pupils with #D23.

**Step 6:** Fire to Cone 03.

**Step 7:** Apply 3 coats of #003 to sea lion sea shells. Fire at Cone 05.

**Step 8:** Apply Mother of Pearl on shells and fire to Cone 018.

**Step 9:** Basecoat base with Sand.

**Step 10:** Antique with True Brown.

**Step 11:** Use washes on sand and rock of Country Blue, Toast and Leather Brown.

**Step 12:** Drybrush Cream over washes. Shade sand and rock with Toast.

**Step 13:** Drybrush coral, Sand and add Cream to brush and drybrush coral. Shade coral with True Orange.

**Step 14:** Drybrush small coral with Lexington Green and highlight with Mustard.

**Step 15:** Shade small sea shells with Skyblue and Petal Pink.

## DH 1454 HUMPBACK WHALES

**Materials Needed:** Greenware, Various Brushes, Airbrush, Matte Spray.

**Ceramicchrome Opaque Underglazes & Glazes:** #81 Cape Cod Grey, #T21 Black, #131 White, #003 Gloss Glaze.

**Step 1:** Clean greenware with cleaning tools.

**Step 2:** Use air-gun and spray top of whale with #81.

**Step 3:** Use #T21 to shade areas.

**Step 4:** Airbrush #131 on belly of whale and top of fins.

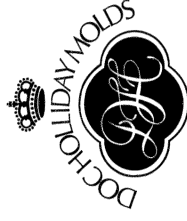
**Step 5:** Paint water #131.

**Step 6:** Fire to Cone 03.

**Step 7:** Antique water with #111 and wipe off with sponge.

**Step 8:** Apply 3 coats of #003 to whale and water.

**Step 9:** Fire to Cone 05.
