

“FANTASIES FOR ALL SEASONS”

TECHNIQUE SHEET 164

Materials Needed: Greenware, Various Brushes, Soft Cloth, Matte Spray Sealer, P-400 Solvent, Rhinestones, Crystal Balls & Ultra Fine Glitter from National Art Craft, Brush on Glitter - Clear, Lavender, Red, Blue, Pink, Silver & Turquoise, Pearl Stains - Orchid, White, Gold & Pink.

Doc Holiday Colors: DH-29 White, DH-30 Country Blue, DH-27 Midnight Blue, DH-15 Mystic Purple, DH-40 Turquoise, DH-34 Soft Brown, DH-19 Light Grey, DH-18 Medium Brown, DH-08 Black, DH-23 Bone, DH-22 Christmas Red, DH-01 Daffodil, DH-50 Regal Purple, DH-09 Real Brown, DH-25 Toast, DH-49 Premier Gold, DH-52 Cranberry, DH-81 Leaf Green, DH-53 Peach, DH-45 Shadow Green, DH-21 Sand, DH-51 Mauve, DH-42 Dark Grey, SP-04 Snow-It, AT-04 Red Brown Translucent, AT-01 Black Translucent & FT-02 Gold Finger-Tip, DH-16 Flaxon Yellow, DH-12 Leather Brown, DH-44 Blue Suede, DH-36 Navy Blue, DH-03 True Orange.

Ceramicchrome Colors: CL-2 Liquid Bright Palladium, CL-3 Mother of Pearl, CL-4 Gold Essence (for cleaning Gold & Silver out of brushes), CL-1 Liquid Bright Gold, 003 Clear Gloss Glaze.

* **NOTE:** For all Gold areas, apply 2 coats of Clear Gloss Glaze to bisque. Fire to Cone 05. Apply Liquid Gold (or Silver) to glazed area. Fire to Cone 018-019. Clean any paint off fired-on gold areas with a cloth dampened with water.

SPRING WIZARD - DH 1579

Step 1: Basecoat skin Soft Brown. Basecoat lights Light Grey. Basecoat hair Flaxon Yellow. Antique with Red Brown Translucent. Drybrush hair with Flaxon Yellow highlight lightly with Cream. Shade part in hair around face with a thin wash of Toast. Paint eyes with Country Blue irises and Black pupils. Paint lips with a thin wash of Leather Brown. Paint eyebrows with Medium Brown.

Step 2: Basecoat all remaining areas Black.

Step 3: Drybrush tunic Cranberry. Add a little White to Cranberry in brush and drybrush highlights on folds and edges of fabric. Drybrush cape with Mauve; drybrush highlights to folds and edges by adding a little White to the Mauve. Shade creases and deep folds a wash of Cranberry. Shade tunic & robe with a Black wash where needed to accent folds and separate colors. Drybrush boots lightly with Dark Grey. Drybrush bird's back and head with Real Brown; highlight feather edges with Toast. Drybrush front of bird White. Shade around wings with a wash of Leather Brown. Paint tips of wing sections & tail White. Paint beak and eyes Flaxon Yellow. Shade bird with a Black wash (around beak, wings, etc.)

Step 4: Drybrush dragon Blue Suede (except fins on head). Drybrush Mauve on back, toes, head, knees and fins; highlight with a little White. Paint ends of fins, humps on back & muzzle White. Shade blue areas with a thin wash of Midnight Blue. Shade pink areas with a Cranberry wash. Shade creases and around toes, mouth areas with a Black wash. Paint eye Cranberry.

Step 5: Apply Mask-It to Gold areas. Spray with Matte Spray Sealer. Remove Mask-It.

Step 6: Highlight Red Brush-On Glitter on eye. Paint Blue Brush-On Glitter on Blue areas of dragon. Paint light pink areas of dragon with Pink Pearl Stain. Highlight White areas with White Pearl Stain. Paint a Black silt pupil in eye. Apply Finger-Tip Gold to belt. Glue crystal in hand and a rhinestone in necklace.

ICE DRAGON - DH 1571

Step 1: Follow directions for Winter Dragon except for belly. Paint belly Turquoise. Shade the sides and indentations with a Midnight Blue wash. Highlight the center of belly with Turquoise lightened with a little White.

FAIRIES - DH 1587 THRU DH 1591

Step 1: Clean greenware and Fire to Cone 03.

Step 2: Basecoat skin with Soft Brown. Antique with Soft Brown Antiquing and wipe back with soft cloth. Drybrush skin with Soft Brown.

Step 3: Basecoat hair with Real Brown. Drybrush with Terra Cotta and then with Christmas Red.

Step 4: Basecoat wings with Shadow Green and drybrush with Grass Green and again with Willow Green.

Step 5: Paint eyes Grass Green lightened with a little White. Pupils are Black with White dot for highlight. Lips are Rose.

Step 6: Spray with Matte Sealer and apply Gold Brush-On Glitter to wings.

PURPLE WINGS

Step 1: Follow directions for Winter Dragon except for belly. Paint belly Turquoise. Shade the sides and indentations with a Midnight Blue wash. Highlight the center of belly with Turquoise lightened with a little White.

SPRING DRAGON - DH 1575

Step 1: Basecoat entire piece Black. Drybrush rocks Light Grey. Tint them with washes of Cranberry, Country Blue & Leather Brown. Shade deepest areas and around dragon with a Black wash. Drybrush dragon (except belly & ridge on back) with Mauve. Highlight by drybrushing with a little White mixed with Mauve. Drybrush belly and back ridge with Blue

Suede. Shade with a wash of Midnight Blue. Shade Mauve areas with a Cranberry wash. Paint highlights and accents on face & belly ridges with White. Drybrush eggs Blue Suede. Shade them with a Midnight Blue wash, then a Black wash. Paint Premier Gold dots on eggs. Drybrush tree Real Brown. With color still in your brush, add Toast and drybrush highlights on bark areas of tree. Add little Blue Suede to same brush and drybrush more highlights on tree. Drybrush smooth areas of tree with Sand. Shade and tint these areas with washes of Toast, Leather Brown & Black. Shade around tree and dragon with a Black wash. Paint mouth Cranberry, teeth Gold and eyes Daffodil.

Step 2: Apply Mask-It to Gold areas. Spray with Matte Spray Sealer. Remove Mask-It. Highlight pink areas of dragon with Pink Pearl Stain. Highlight White areas with White Pearl Stain. Apply Pink Brush-On Glitter to wings. Glue rhinestones in eyes.

SUMMER DRAGON - DH 1576

Step 1: Basecoat entire piece Black. Drybrush rocks Bone. Tint rocks with washes of Cranberry & Country Blue. Drybrush rocks again with Cream; shade crevices with a Black wash. Drybrush coral with Peach. Apply a thin wash of Cranberry over the Peach; let dry, then highlight edges lightly with Daffodil. Drybrush shells White. Shade flat shells with a wash of Cranberry, making the edges of each shell the lightest. Tint other shells with a thin wash of Midnight Blue.

Step 2: Drybrush dragon with Leaf Green. With color still in your brush, add increasing amounts of Daffodil and drybrush highlights on the dragon. Make around the face, feet and hair on neck very yellow. Shade around face, fins, toes and Gold areas with a wash of Midnight Blue. Paint tongue, eye & ridges on neck Cranberry. Paint teeth Bone.

Step 3: Apply Mask-It to Gold areas. Spray with Matte Spray Sealer. Remove Mask-It.

Step 4: Drybrush Gold Pearl Stain on sides and around face of dragon. Drybrush edges of shells and randomly on rocks with White Pearl Stain. Paint Cranberry ridges on neck with Red Brush-On Glitter. Paint darkest parts of dragon with Green Brush-On Glitter. Paint light parts and around face with Yellow Brush-On Glitter. Glue a rhinestone in eye.

SUMMER WIZARD - DH 1580

Step 1: Basecoat dress and closed book pages with Flaxon Yellow. Basecoat open book pages and beard Light Grey. Basecoat skin Soft Brown. Antique basecoated areas with Red Brown Translucent, wiping away excess stain with soft cloth. Drybrush beard and open book pages with Light Grey; highlight by drybrushing edges lightly with White. Drybrush dress with Flaxon Yellow; add a little White to same brush and drybrush highlights on folds and edges. Shade creases and center of book with a thin Toast wash. Shade center of book again with a thin Black wash. "Write" on book pages with Black. Paint eyes with Country Blue irises and Black pupils and lashes.

Step 2: Basecoat all remaining areas Black.

Step 3: Drybrush ground Light Grey. Shade with washes of Real Brown, Leather Brown, Country Blue and Black. Drybrush lightly with Cream to blend colors. Shade around tree and wizard and crevices with a wash of Black. Drybrush tree Real Brown. With color still in your brush, add Toast and drybrush highlights on bark parts of tree. Drybrush smoother, barkless parts of tree with Sand. Shade these areas with washes of Toast, Real Brown and Black.

Step 4: Drybrush dragon Leaf Green. Highlight face, feet and center of back with Daffodil. Paint stomach Daffodil. Shade edges and between sections and around neck fins with Christmas Red. Paint Daffodil dots on toes and down nose and center of back. Paint Christmas Red and Daffodil stripes on tail. Paint toenails Christmas Red. Drybrush top book Grass Green. Drybrush center book and book on lap Navy Blue. Drybrush bottom book Christmas Red. Shade between books and around bindings with Black. Drybrush wizard's robe Grass Green. Add Daffodil to same brush and drybrush highlights on robe. Shade folds and edges of robe with a Black wash. Paint belt Grass Green.

Step 5: Apply Mask-It to Gold areas. Spray with Matte Spray Sealer. Remove Mask-It. Paint 2 coats of Green Brush-On Glitter to collar and belt. Moisturize brush with P-400 Solvent and use to paint on Finger-Tip Gold on front of robe. Also lightly highlight book page edges with Finger-Tip Gold. Glue rhinestones in center sections of necklace. Glue crystal on side of chair.

WINTER WIZARD - DH 1582

Step 1: Basecoat ice White. Shade ice with a thin wash of Country Blue, allowing the most color to stay in the crevices. Shade just the crevices and base of ice sticks with a thin wash of Midnight Blue. Tint the ice lightly with washes of Mystic Purple & Turquoise. Drybrush the ice with White to blend the colors. Make edges & tops of ice very White.

Step 2: Basecoat skin Soft Brown and beard and hair Light Grey. Antique skin by applying a wash of Medium Brown; wipe off highlights while still wet. "Antique" beard and hair in same manner, using a Black wash. Drybrush beard and hair with Light Grey; highlight with White. Paint eyes with Country Blue irises, outline with Midnight Blue and Black pupils and lashes. Shade edges of beard and next to hat with a thin Black wash.

Step 3: Basecoat robe (except fur) and hat Midnight Blue. With color still in your brush add increasing amounts of White and drybrush highlights on folds and edges. Shade deep folds and next to fur with a Black wash. Paint fur White. Shade where fur overlaps with a Country Blue wash. Paint shoes Black.

Step 4: Apply Mask-It to Fired-On Silver areas. Spray with Matte Spray Sealer. Remove

Mask-It. Paint fur with Clear Brush-On Glitter. Paint dot pattern on robe with Silver Glitter. Glue crystal in hand.

WINTER DRAGON - DH 1578

Step 1: Paint ice as instructed for Winter Wizard.

Step 2: Basecoat dragon Black. Drybrush entire dragon with Midnight Blue. With color still in your brush, add increasing amounts of White and drybrush dragon again, highlighting the high points of body with the lighter blue. Drybrush Mystic Purple on wing tips, around face, eyes, toes, knees and center part of tail and chest. Drybrush Turquoise on fronts of wings and lightly on knees and fins on face. Paint White accents on fins and cheeks. Paint tongue Christmas Red. Paint eyes Daffodil with Christmas Red fins and Black silt pupil. Paint teeth Bone.

Step 3: Apply Mask-It to Fired-On Silver. Spray with Matte Spray Sealer. Remove Mask-It. Apply Snow-It to tops of icicles and sprinkle with glitter while still wet.

Step 4: Drybrush purple areas of body with Orchid Pearl Stain. Drybrush blue parts of body with Blue Pearl Stain. Paint Turquoise Brush-On Glitter on fronts of wings. Paint Lavender Brush-On Glitter on wing tips.

FALL DRAGON - DH 1572

Step 1: Basecoat entire piece Black.

Step 2: Drybrush castle and rocks Light Grey. Shade rocks with washes of True Orange, Regal Purple and Country Blue. Drybrush lightly with Cream. Shade bricks with a True Orange wash, shade rock parts of castle with a Red wash. Highlight by adding Cream of Orange or Red then drybrush edges and windows. Shade around rocks, windows, corners, etc. with a Black wash.

Step 3: Drybrush dragon Regal Purple. Lighten with White and drybrush highlights. Drybrush wing tips, back ridge and around face True Orange; add Daffodil and highlight orange areas. Paint tongue Red. Paint teeth Premier Gold. Paint Whit accents on face. Paint eye Daffodil. Shade dragon with Black.

Step 4: Apply Mask-It to Fired-On Gold. Spray with Matte Spray Sealer. Remove Mask-It. Paint Orchid Pearl on dragon to highlight. Paint White Pearl on rocks to highlight. Lavender Glitter on front of wings. Sprinkle Ultra-Fine Glitter on back ridge and wing tips. Glue rhinestones in eyes.

Materials Needed: Greenware, Various Brushes, Airbrush (if desired), Soft Cloth, Pale Pink Chalk, Matte Spray Sealer, Pastel Lavender Liquid Glitter, Ultra-Fine Glitter, Clear Gloss Glaze & Liquid Bright Gold.

Doc Holiday Colors: DH-29 White, DH-08 Black, DH-44 Blue Suede, DH-15 Mystic Purple, DH-43 Teal, DH-02 Butter Cream, SP02 Mask-It, SP05 Doc's Glue.

PEGASUS - DH 1573 & UNICORN - DH 1574

* **NOTE:** Steps 1 thru 5 are for both pieces. Color on wings, mane tail and clouds may be airbrushed if desired.

Step 1: Clean and fire greenware to Cone 03.

Step 2: Apply 2 coats Clear Gloss Glaze to hooves & Unicorn's horn. Fire to Cone 05.

Step 3: Apply Liquid bright Gold to glazed areas. Fire to Cone 018.

Step 4: Basecoat entire piece White. Clean off Gold areas with cloth dampened with water.

Step 5: Lightly dust around eyes and muzzle with Pale Pink Chalk. Paint eyes with Blue Suede irises. Rim irises with a Teal wash. Paint pupil and outline eye with Black. Paint a "star" highlight in eye with White. Apply Mask-It to Gold areas. Spray with Matte Spray Sealer. Remove Mask-It. Brush on Pastel Lavender Liquid Glitter to mane and tail. Brush a coat of Doc's Glue on clouds. While still wet, sprinkle with Ultra-Fine Glitter.

For Unicorn Only:

Apply a thin wash of Blue Suede to mane, tail and feathering on legs. Make the ends of tail and mane darkest. Drybrush over wash with White, making hair nearest neck and body very White.

For Pegasus Only:

Follow above directions for mane & tail. Shade sections of wing feathers with Blue Suede; corner-load brush with color and shade where sections join. Tint feather section next to outside section very lightly with a wash of Butter Cream. Tint middle area of feather sections with a very thin wash of Mystic Purple. Blend the colors by drybrushing edges of sections with White. The colors should be very subtle and blended. Shade and tint clouds with thin washes of Blue Suede, Butter Cream and Mystic Purple. Drybrush clouds with White to blend colors.



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
