

“NEW DRIFTWOOD COLLECTIBLES”

MATERIALS NEEDED FOR ALL PIECES: Greenware, Various Brushes, Matte Spray Sealer, Airbrush, Solvent, Glitter, Russet Chalk

DH-1832 DRIFTWOOD BEAR

DOC HOLIDAY COLORS: DH08-Black, DH09-Real Brown, DH18-Medium Brown, DH25-Toast, DH21-Sand, DH37-Cream, DH12-Leather Brown, DH30-Country Blue

Step 1: Basecoat entire piece Black.
Step 2: Wet-brush over Black with Real Brown. Add Medium Brown to same brush and wet-brush bear again. Add Sand to same brush and wet-brush muzzle and highlight fur. Shade around muzzle with a wash of Real Brown. Paint nose Black. Paint eye Real Brown with Black pupils. Shade bears' fur in crevices with a Black wash.

Step 3: Wet-brush wood with Toast. Add Cream to same brush and wet-brush washes of Country Blue, Leather Brown, Toast and Black.
Step 4: Spray with Matte Spray Sealer.

DH-1831 DRIFTWOOD WOLF

DOC HOLIDAY COLORS: DH08-Black, DH37-Cream, DH19-Light Grey, DH25-Toast, DH09-Real Brown, DH12-Leather Brown, DH22-Christmas Red, DH10-Mustard, DH30-Country Blue, AT01-Black Translucent

Step 1: Basecoat entire piece Light Grey. Antique with Black translucent stain.
Step 2: Wet-brush wolf and wood with Light Grey. Shade wolfs fur with washes of Toast, Real Brown, and Black. Wet-brush lighter areas of fur with Cream. Paint mouth Christmas Red, nose Black, eyes Mustard with Black pupils.

Step 3: Shade and tint the wood with washes of Real Brown, Toast, Leather Brown, Country Blue, and Black. Highlight wood by wet-brushing with Cream.
Step 4: Spray with Matte Spray Sealer.

DH-1830 DRIFTWOOD ELEPHANT

DOC HOLIDAY COLORS: DH08-Black, DH42-Dark Grey, DH19-Light Grey, DH37-Cream, DH14-Rose, DH25-Toast, DH09-Real Brown, DH12-Leather Brown, DH33-Deep Beige, DH30-Country Blue, AT01-Black Translucent

Step 1: Basecoat entire piece Dark Grey. Antique with Black Translucent.
Step 2: Wet-brush elephant with Dark Grey. Add Light Grey to same brush and wet-brush again, highlighting lighter areas with Cream. Lightly tint ears and mouth with a Rose wash.
Step 3: Shade crevices with a Black wash.
Step 4: Wet-brush wood with Deep Beige. Shade and tint wood with washes of Toast, Real Brown, Leather Brown, Country Blue and Black. Highlight wood by wet-brushing edges with Cream.
Step 5: Spray with Matte Spray Sealer.

DH-1829 DRIFTWOOD LION

DOC HOLIDAY COLORS: DH08-Black, DH21-Sand, DH25-Toast, DH10-Mustard, DH16-Flaxen Yellow, DH37-Cream, DH12-Leather Brown, DH09-Real Brown, DH30-Country Blue, AT02-Black Brown Translucent

Step 1: Basecoat entire piece with Toast. Antique with Black Brown translucent.
Step 2: Wet-brush lion with Toast. Add Mustard to same brush and wet-brush again. Keep the mane darker than the face. Add Flaxen Yellow to same brush and lightly highlight fur. Wet-brush muzzle and around eyes with Cream. Paint eyes Mustard, with Black pupils. Shade fur with a Black Wash.

Step 3: Wet-brush wood with Sand. Shade and tint the wood with washes of Toast, Leather Brown, Real Brown, Country Blue, and Black. Highlight edges of wood with Cream.
Step 4: Spray with Matte Spray Sealer.

DH-1833 DRIFTWOOD HORSES

DOC HOLIDAY COLORS: DH08-Black, DH29-White, DH09-Real Brown, DH12-Leather Brown, DH30-Country Blue, DH25-Toast, DH19-Light Grey, AT01-Black Translucent

Step 1: Airbrush entire piece White. Slightly darken the White with a little Black. Airbrush this on mane, muzzle, around eyes, joints and in muscle indentations. Antique entire piece with Black translucent. Use solvent to get the horses as White as possible.
Step 2: Wet-brush the manes with White; shade manes, neck, neck with a Black wash. Paint eyes Real Brown, with Black pupils.

Step 3: Wet-brush the wood with Light Grey. Shade and tint the wood with washes of Toast, Country Blue, Leather Brown, Real Brown, and Black. Highlight edges with Cream.
Step 4: Spray with Matte Spray Sealer.

DOC HOLIDAY COLORS FOR ALL PLATES: DH08-Black, DH29-White, DH10-Mustard, DH37-Cream, DH25-Toast, DH09-Real Brown, DH18-Medium Brown

DH-1769 BEAR PLATE

Step 1: Basecoat background with Toast. Pounce 'n blend with a mixture of Toast and Flaxen Yellow.
Step 2: Finish the bear as directed for "Driftwood Bear".

DH-1766 WOLF PLATE

Step 1: Basecoat background with Blue Suede. Pounce 'n blend with a mixture of Blue suede and Cream.
Step 2: Finish wolf as directed for "Driftwood Wolf".

DH-1765 EAGLE PLATE

Step 1: Basecoat background with Mustard. Pounce 'n blend with a mixture of Mustard and Cream.
Step 2: Basecoat head with White. Tint beak and eye with Mustard wash. Shade with a Toast wash. Shade around eye and beak with a Black wash. Paint pupil Black.
Step 3: Basecoat neck Black. Wet-brush with Real Brown; highlight with Medium Brown.
Step 4: Spray with Matte Spray Sealer.

DH-1814 BOY WITH LION

DOC HOLIDAY COLORS: DH08-Black, DH29-White, DH37-Cream, DH09-Real Brown, DH10-Mustard, DH25-Toast, DH16-Flaxen Yellow, DH12-Leather Brown, DH14-Rose, DH47-Silver, DH22-Christmas Red, DH19-Light Grey, DH30-Country Blue, DH38-Grass Green, DH45-Shadow Yellow, AT01-Black Translucent

Step 1: Basecoat lion, boy and lamb with Real Brown.
Step 2: Antique boy and lion's mane with Black Translucent. Wipe away excess stain with a soft cloth.
Step 3: Paint boy's eyes with Real Brown, iris' and Black pupils. Paint eyebrows and hair Black. Paint lips with a wash of Rose and Leather Brown.
Step 4: Wet-brush lion with Toast. Lighten color by wet-brushing with Mustard, then Flaxen Yellow. Wet-brush muzzle and under eyes with Cream. Keep the mane darker than the body. Paint nose with a mixture of Rose and Leather Brown. Paint eyes Mustard with Black pupils and outline. Paint lips and whisker markings Black.
Step 5: Paint boy's armbands Silver. Wet-brush his wrap with Christmas Red.
Step 6: Shade lion with a Black wash. (Around legs, nose, eyes, mouth, toes, muscles, and end of tail.)
Step 7: Wet-brush lamb Cream. Highlight with White. Paint nose Rose. Tint inside ears with a thin wash of Rose. Paint eyes Black; shade around legs with a Black wash.
Step 8: Basecoat remaining areas with Black.

Step 9: Wet-brush rocks with Light Grey. Tint and shade them with washes of Toast, Leather Brown and Country Blue. Lightly wet-brush them with Cream to highlight.
Step 10: Wet-brush ground and leaves with Real Brown. Repeat with Grass Green. Add Mustard to same brush and wet-brush again. Add more Mustard to same brush and wet-brush highlights on leaves and edges of ground-cover. Add Flaxen Yellow to same brush and wet-brush more highlights. Shade and tint the leaves and ground-cover with washes of Shadow Green, Toast, and Leather Brown.

Step 11: Shade ground area with a Black wash. Use a liner and Black to define detail where necessary.
Step 12: Spray with Matte Spray Sealer.

DH-1812 ELEPHANT

DOC HOLIDAY COLORS: DH08-Black, DH29-White, DH19-Light Grey, DH42-Dark Grey, DH25-Toast, DH12-Leather Brown, DH38-Grass Green, DH45-Shadow Green, DH10-Mustard, DH16-Flaxen Yellow, DH37-Cream, DH14-Rose, DH09-Real Brown, DH30-Country Blue, AT01-Black Translucent

Step 1: Basecoat elephant with Light Grey.
Step 2: Antique elephant with Black Translucent Stain. Wipe off excess stain with cloth dampened with Cleaner/Solvent.
Step 3: Paint tusks and toenails Cream.
Step 4: Wet-brush elephant with Light Grey. Shade creases, deepest wrinkles; around eyes, etc. with a Dark Grey wash. Shade again with a Black wash, darkening end of tail and shading around mouth and toenails.

Step 5: Shade tusks with a Toast wash, followed by a Black wash. Highlight tips of tusks by wet-brushing with White. Lightly tint ears, front of trunk and inside mouth with a Rose wash. Paint eyes with Toast and Real Brown iris. and Black pupils.
Step 6: Basecoat remaining areas Black.
Step 7: Wet-brush rocks with Light Grey. Tint and shade them with washes of Toast, Real Brown, Grass Green, and Country Blue.

Lightly wet-brush them with Cream to highlight.
Step 8: Wet-brush all grass areas with Real Brown. Repeat with Grass Green. Add Mustard to same brush and wet-brush again. Add more Mustard to same brush and wet-brush highlights on the leaves and grasses. Add Flaxen Yellow to same brush and add more highlights. Shade some of the leaves with a Shadow Green wash. Tint some of the grasses with washes of Toast and Leather Brown.
Step 9: Shade rocks, grasses and leaves with a Black wash. Use a liner with Black to define and separate some of the leaves and grasses.
Step 10: Spray with Matte Spray Sealer.

DH-1813 CHEETAH AND ANTELOPE

DOC HOLIDAY COLORS: DH19-Light Grey, DH25-Toast, DH12-Leather Brown, DH30-Country Blue, DH09-Black, DH09-Real Brown, DH38-Grass Green, DH10-Mustard, DH16-Flaxen Yellow, DH45-Shadow Green, DH37-Cream

Step 1: Basecoat cheetah Flaxen Yellow. Tint upper body with a Toast wash. Wet-brush "white" markings on lower body, face, and inside ears with Cream. Shade body with a Real Brown wash. Paint spots with Black. Paint nose Leather Brown. Shade around ears and nose and face markings with a Black wash.
Step 2: Basecoat dark areas of antelope with Toast. Basecoat remaining parts White. Shade body with a Real Brown wash. Paint Black markings on sides, ears, and face.
Step 3: Basecoat remaining areas Black.
Step 4: Wet-brush rocks Light Grey. Shade and tint them with washes of Toast, Leather Brown, Country Blue, and Black. Highlight rocks with Cream.

Step 5: Wet-brush grass with Real Brown, then Grass Green.
Accent and shade the grass with Mustard, Leather Brown, Shadow Green, Flaxen Yellow, and Black.
Step 6: Spray with Matte Spray Sealer.

DH-1835 INDIAN ANGEL WITH EAGLE

DOC HOLIDAY COLORS: DH09-Real Brown, DH12-Leather Brown, DH08-Black, DH29-White, DH16-Flaxen Yellow, DH07-Dark Flesh, DH37-Cream, DH25-Toast, DH40-Turquoise, DH10-Mustard, DH18-Medium Brown, DH21-Sand, AT04-Red Brown Translucent

Step 1: Basecoat skin Dark Flesh. Basecoat dress Flaxen Yellow. Antique these areas with Red Brown translucent.
Step 2: Wet-brush fringe with Flaxen Yellow; lighten ends with Cream. Paint base Flaxen Yellow. Shade upper edges of fringe and top and bottom of base with a Toast wash. Paint "beads" on dress with Turquoise and White.

Step 3: Basecoat wings Cream; cloud and eagle's head White; hair and eagle (except head) and tree Black.
Step 4: Tint eagle's beak and eyes with a Mustard wash. Shade them with a Toast wash. Paint pupils Black.
Step 5: Shade between wing sections with a Flaxen Yellow wash. Shade erring feathers with a Leather Brown wash.
Step 6: Wet-brush eagle and tree with Real Brown. Add Medium Brown to same brush and highlight eagle's feathers. Wet-brush feet with Mustard.

Step 7: Wet-brush tree with Toast. Wet-brush smooth areas of tree with Sand. Tint and shade tree with washes of Toast, Real Brown, Leather Brown, and Black. Highlight edges lightly with Cream.

Step 8: Paint lips with a thin wash of Leather Brown. Paint eyes with Real Brown iris. Black pupils. Blush skin with chalk.
Step 9: Apply glitter to cloud.

DH-1794 EAGLE DANCER

DOC HOLIDAY COLORS: DH08-Black, DH29-White, DH37-Cream, DH25-Toast, DH09-Real Brown, DH18-Medium Flesh, DH12-Leather Brown, DH10-Mustard, DH07-Dark Flesh, AT04-Red Brown Translucent.

Step 1: Clean greenware and fire to cone 03.
Step 2: Paint Indian flesh with Dark Flesh and antique with Red Brown translucent. Wipe off with a soft cloth.

Step 3: Paint feathers on eagle, rocks and Indians hair with Black.
Step 4: Paint Indian's loin cloth Medium Brown. Paint fringe and shoes Leather Brown.

Step 5: Paint eagle's top feathers of head White and the beak Mustard.
Step 6: Drybrush Leather Brown on lower half of eagle leathers and highlight with Toast. Drybrush Medium Brown on upper section of feathers and highlight with Cream.

Step 7: Shade eagle's beak and around eyes with Toast then a wash of Black.
Step 8: Paint Indian's lips with a wash of Leather Brown and pupils Black with Real Brown iris'. Shade cheeks and muscles with Russet Chalk.

Step 9: Decorate bead work on fringe and shoes.
Step 10: Paint washes of Mustard, Toast and Real Brown on rocks and drybrush with Matte Spray Sealer.
Step 11: Spray with Matte Spray Sealer.

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
