

DH1804 - MT. CITADEL

MATERIALS AND COLORS NEEDED: Greenware, various brushes, liquid fired gold, gazing ball, CG300 Clear Glaze, liquid soap, DH08 Black, DH10 Mustard, DH19 Light Grey, DH25 Toast, DH31 Leaf Green, DH37 Cream, DH38 Grass Green, G3 Green Glitter, G5 Copper Glitter, SP02 Mask-It, SP05 Doc's Glue, SP08 Matte Spray

STEP 1: Clean greenware and fire to cone 03. Clear glaze all roof tops and fire to cone 05. Apply liquid fired gold to glazed areas and fire to cone 018.

STEP 2: Basecoat entire piece black including gazing ball holder. Wetbrush all black areas with Light Grey. Make a thin wash of Leaf Green and Mustard and tint bricks randomly. Shade bricks with Grass Green and Toast.

STEP 3: Use Grass Green and Toast to tint rocks. Highlight rocks with Cream. Shade rocks with Black. Paint all doors and windows Black.

STEP 4: Dip a brush in liquid soap and then Mask-It and brush over gold. Spray with Matte Spray sealer. Refer to photo for areas to be glittered and brush on Doc's Glue and then sprinkle glitter.

DH2441 - "THE LOOKOUT" DRAGON

MATERIALS AND COLORS NEEDED: greenware, various brushes, CG300 Clear Glaze, liquid fired gold, SP08 Matte Spray, DH01 Daffodil, DH03 True Orange, DH06 Lavender, DH08 Black, DH10 Mustard, DH15 Mystic Purple, DH19 Light Grey, DH25 Toast, DH27 Midnight Blue, DH37 Cream

STEP 1: Basecoat dragon's body and wings Mystic Purple. Wetbrush Lavender over Mystic Purple to highlight. Basecoat body and legs with True Orange and highlight with Daffodil. Shade all areas with Midnight Blue.

STEP 2: Basecoat remaining areas Black. Wetbrush Light Grey on rocks. Add washes of Toast, True Orange and Mustard. Highlight with Cream. Shade all areas with Black.

STEP 3: Spray with Matte Spray.

DH2329 - DRIFTWOOD HATCHLINGS

MATERIALS AND COLORS NEEDED: Greenware, various brushes, DH06 Lavender, DH08 Black, DH09 Real Brown, DH12 Leather Brown, DH13 Petal Pink, DH15 Mystic Purple, DH21 Sand, DH25 Toast, DH27 Midnight Blue, DH37 Cream, SP08 Matte Spray, SP12 Pearl It

STEP 1: Basecoat entire piece black. Wetbrush dragons with Mystic Purple. Highlight wings and face with Lavender. Shade with Midnight Blue.

STEP 2: Wetbrush eggs with Cream. Add washes of Petal Pink and Lavender. Use Pearl-It on eggs.

STEP 3: Wetbrush wood Real Brown. Add washes of Toast, Leather Brown, and Sand. Highlight with Cream. Shade wood with Black.

STEP 4: Paint eyes Daffodil with Black Iris.

STEP 5: Spray with Matte Spray.

DH2434 - PROTECTOR OF REFLECTION

MATERIALS AND COLORS NEEDED: greenware, various brushes, CG300 Clear Glaze, liquid fired gold, DH01 Daffodil, DH04 True Red, DH05 Purple, DH06 Lavender, DH08 Black, DH09 Real Brown, DH19 Light Grey, DH21 Sand, DH22 Christmas Red, DH25 Toast, DH27 Midnight Blue, DH29 White, DH30 Country Blue, DH31 Leaf Green, DH41 Willow Green, SP08 Matte Spray, SP14 Antique-It

STEP 1: Basecoat dragons body and wings Daffodil. Basecoat legs and belly Purple. Basecoat remaining areas Light Grey.

STEP 2: Apply 50 / 50 Antique-It and Leaf Green to wings and body. Wipe off with soft cloth. Use water to soften color if needed.

STEP 3: Wetbrush Lavender on belly and legs. Highlight body and face with Daffodil. Shade over lavender areas and around face with Midnight Blue. Paint eyes Purple with True Red Iris.

STEP 4: Wetbrush rocks with washes of Toast, Willow Green and Country Blue. Wetbrush tree Real Brown and highlight with Sand. Wetbrush crystals White and shade with Purple and Midnight Blue. Shade rocks and tree with Black.

STEP 5: Put Mask-It on gold areas and spray with Matte Spray sealer.

DH2417 - LARGE GARDEN CASTLE

DH2418 - LARGE GARDEN DRAGON

MATERIALS AND COLORS NEEDED: Bisque, brushes (DH86 1/2" shader, DH83 round, DH81 liner), DH01 Daffodil, DH03 True Orange, DH08 Black, DH12 Leather Brown, DH19 Light Grey, DH22 Christmas Red, DH37 Cream, DH44 Blue Suede, DH49 Premier Gold, DH52 Cranberry, SP08 Matte Spray, SP14 Antique-It

STEP 1: Basecoat entire dragon except belly Daffodil. Basecoat belly True Orange.

STEP 2: Apply one coat Krackle-It over belly. Let dry. Apply one heavy coat Daffodil over Krackle-It on belly. Let dry thoroughly.

STEP 3: Antique all remaining areas of dragon with True Orange mixed 1/2 and 1/2 with Antique-It. Wipe away excess color with a paper towel.

STEP 4: Shade and tint edges and crevices of dragon as desired using washes of Christmas Red and Cranberry. Paint tongue Cranberry and teeth Cream.

STEP 5: Basecoat entire castle Black.

STEP 6: Wetbrush stones on castle with Light Grey. Shade and tint them with washes of True Orange and Blue Suede. Lightly highlight stones with Cream.

STEP 7: Wetbrush all bricks on castle with Leather Brown; highlight with True Orange.

STEP 8: Paint roofs that are not fired gold with Premier Gold. Paint doorways and ledges Black. Shade castle as necessary with a Black wash.

STEP 9: Spray with Matte Spray sealer.

DH2383 - DRAGON OF REFLECTION

MATERIALS AND COLORS NEEDED: Bisque, DH86 1/2" shader, DH83 round, DH81 liner, DH08 Black, DH12 Leather Brown, DH15 Mystic Purple, DH19 Light Grey, DH25 Toast, DH27 Midnight Blue, DH30 Country Blue, DH37 Cream, SP08 Matte Spray, SP12 Pearl-It

STEP 1: Basecoat entire piece black.

STEP 2: Wetbrush rocks with Light Grey. Shade and tint rocks with washes of Toast, Leather Brown, Midnight Blue, and Country Blue. Lightly wetbrush rocks with Cream to highlight. Shade rocks as needed with a Black wash.

STEP 3: Wetbrush dragon with Country Blue. Highlight wings and body with Mystic Purple. Highlight belly with "pearlized" Mystic Purple. Shade dragon with a wash of Midnight Blue.

STEP 4: Spray with Matte Spray sealer.

DH2330 - THE "LAST" DRAGON

MATERIALS AND COLORS NEEDED: Various brushes (B1, B6, B3), Glitter (your choice of color), soft cloth, DH01 Daffodil, DH06 Lavender, DH08 Black, DH14 Rose, DH15 Mystic Purple, DH19 Light Grey, DH23 Bone, DH27 Midnight Blue, DH37 Cream, DH40 Turquoise, SP14 Antique-It

STEP 1: Basecoat dragon with Mystic Purple. Basecoat rocks and bones Black.

STEP 2: Wetbrush rocks with Light Grey. Apply washes of Mystic Purple and Midnight Blue to rocks and highlight with Cream. Wetbrush bones with Bone and highlight with Cream. Shade areas with Black.

STEP 3: Use Antique-It 50% / 50% with Midnight Blue. Wipe off with soft cloth (use water to soften color). On dragon and wings wetbrush Lavender. Shade with Turquoise on face, legs, wings and body area. Paint spikes on wings and back Cream. Paint teeth Cream. Paint tongue Rose. Paint eyes Daffodil with Black Iris.

STEP 4: Spray with Matte Spray sealer.

STEP 5: Use Doc's glitter on wings and dragon (any color).

DH2442 - DRAGON OF THE RUINS

MATERIALS AND COLORS NEEDED: Greenware, gazing ball, various brushes, liquid fired gold, CG300 Clear Glaze, DH04 True Red, DH08 Black, DH09 Real Brown, DH12 Leather Brown, DH18 Medium Brown, DH19 Light Grey, DH29 White, DH30 Country Blue, DH36 Navy Blue, DH37 Cream, DH49 Premier Gold, DH52 Cranberry, G8 White Glitter, SP02 Mask-It, SP08 Matte Spray, SP12 Pearl-It

STEP 1: Clean greenware and fire to cone 03. Clear glaze areas to have fired-on-gold (refer to flyer for placement of gold). Fire glaze to cone 05. Apply liquid gold to glazed areas and fire to cone 018.

STEP 2: Basecoat piece Black. Wetbrush dragon with Navy Blue. Wetbrush the body with two coats of White. Leave belly Navy Blue. Shade dragon with Cranberry using a 1/2" shader brush and corner-loading. Paint tongue True Red and teeth Cream. Eyes are Cranberry with Navy Blue pupils. Paint down center of body with Premier Gold.

STEP 3: Wetbrush bricks Real Brown and then Medium Brown. Highlight edges with Cream. Shade bricks with Leather Brown.

STEP 4: Wetbrush rocks Light Grey and apply washes of Country Blue and Cranberry to rocks. Mix White and Pearl-It and highlight rocks. Shade entire piece with Black.

STEP 5: Use a wet paper towel to clean paint off of gold. Follow directions on jar of Mask-It and apply to gold areas. Allow to dry. Spray with Matte Spray and sprinkle glitter over dragon before spray dries. Remove Mask-It.

* You may use your choice of glitter color.
