DH1726 - ALIEN HEAD SMOKER AND BASE

MATERIALS AND COLORS NEEDED: DH08 Black, DH31 Leaf Green, DH45 Shadow Green, DH49 Premier Gold, FT02 Fingertip Gold, SP08 Matte Spray

STEP 1: Basecoat piece Leaf Green. Add a wash of Premier Gold. Corner shade mouth, eyes and neck with Shadow Green.

STEP 2: Paint eyes Black.

STEP 3: Apply FT02 Gold to band. Spray with Matte Spray.

DH2484 WARRIOR DRAGON

MATERIALS AND COLORS NEEDED: DH01 Daffodil, DH03 True Orange, DH04 True Red, DH06 Lavender, DH08 Black, DH09 Real Brown, DH10 Mustard, DH13 Light Grey, DH23 Bone, DH30 Country Blue, DH35 Powder Blue, DH37 Cream, DH39 Bright Blue, SP02 Mask-It, SP08 Matte Spray, Fired-on Gold, glitter, CG300 Clear Glaze

STEP 1: Clean greenware and fire to cone 03.

STEP 2: Apply two coats of Clear Glaze to areas with fired-on gold. Fire to cone 05. Apply one coat of fired-on gold to glazed areas and fire to cone 018.

STEP 3: Basecoat piece Black. Wetbrush dragon and wings Midnight Blue and highlight with Lavender. Paint belly Bright Blue and highlight with Powder Blue. Shade with Bright Blue.

STEP 4: Wetbrush inside of wings and markings on belly with True Orange. Highlight with Daffodil.

STEP 5: Paint teeth Bone. Paint tongue and eyes True Red.

STEP 6: Wetbrush rocks Light Grey. Add washes of Mustard, Country Blue and Real Brown. Wetbrush rocks Cream.

STEP 7: Apply Mask-It to fired-on gold. Spray with Matte Spray. Remove Mask-It and add glitter.

DH2485 SMALL LOOKOUT DRAGON

MATERIALS AND COLORS NEEDED: DH01 Daffodil, DH08 Black, DH09 Real Brown, DH10 Mustard, DH12 Leather Brown, DH16 Flaxon Yellow, DH25 Toast, DH30 Country Blue, DH37 Cream, FT05 Fingertip Copper, SP02 Mask-It, SP08 Matte Spray, Fired On Gold, CG300 Clear Glaze, glitter

STEP 1: Clean greenware and fire to cone 03.

STEP 2: Apply two coats of Clear Glaze to areas with Fired On Gold. Fire to cone 05. Apply one coat of Fired On Gold to glazed areas and fire to cone 018.

STEP 3: Basecoat piece Black. Wetbrush dragon body with Toast. Highlight body with Flaxon Yellow. Wetbrush wings Leather Brown and highlight with Flaxon Yellow. Wetbrush legs and face with Flaxon Yellow. Apply FT05 Copper to dragon and wings. Shade edges of wings and crevices in wings and body with Black.

STEP 4: Paint toenails Bone and eyes Daffodil.

STEP 5: Wetbrush rocks Light Grey. Add washes of

Mustard, Country Blue and Real Brown. Wetbrush rocks with Cream.

STEP 6: Apply Mask-It to Fired On Gold areas. Spray with Matte Spray and remove Mask-It. Apply glitter.

DH2486 SMALL DRAGON OF THE RUINS

MATERIALS AND COLORS NEEDED: DH01 Daffodil, DH08 Black, DH09 Real Brown, DH10 Mustard, DH13 Petal Pink, DH19 Light Grey, DH23 Bone, DH27 Midnight Blue, DH30 Country Blue, DH35 Powder Blue, DH50 Regal Purple, DH51 Mauve, SP02 Mask-It, SP08 Matte Spray, CG300 Clear Glaze, Fired On Gold, glitter

STEP 1: Clean greenware and fire to cone 03.

STEP 2: Apply two coats of Clear Glaze to areas with fired gold. Fire to cone 05. Apply one coat of Fired On Gold to glazed areas and fire to cone 018.

STEP 3: Basecoat piece Black. Wetbrush dragon body with Midnight Blue and highlight with Powder Blue. Wetbrush tip of wings, legs and tip of nose with Mauve. Highlight with Petal Pink. Wetbrush top section of wings with Regal Purple.

STEP 4: Paint toenails Bone and eyes Daffodil.

STEP 5: Wetbrush bricks with Country Blue, Mauve and Cream. Shade with Midnight Blue.

STEP 6: Wetbrush rocks Light Grey. Add washes of Mustard, Country Blue and Real Brown. Wetbrush rocks with Cream.

STEP 7: Apply Mask-It to Fired-On Gold areas. Spray with Matte Spray and then remove Mask-It.

DH2487 SMALL CAPTURED DRAGON

MATERIALS AND COLORS NEEDED: DH08 Black, DH09 Real Brown, DH10 Mustard, DH19 Light Grey, DH22 Christmas Red, DH23 Bone, DH27 Midnight Blue, DH30 Country Blue, DH31 Leaf Green, DH37 Cream, DH41 Willow Green, DH43 Teal, SP02 Mask-It, SP08 Matte Spray, CG300 Clear Glaze, Fired On Gold, glitter

STEP 1: Clean greenware and fire to cone 03.

STEP 2: Apply two coats of Clear Glaze to areas with fired gold. Fire to cone 05. Apply one coat of Fired On Gold to glazed areas and fire to cone 018.

STEP 3: Basecoat piece Black. Wetbrush dragon Teal and highlight with Leaf Green. Highlight tip of wings with Willow Green. Shade creviced areas with Midnight Blue.

STEP 4: Paint toenails and teeth with Bone. Paint tongue Christmas Red. Paint eyes Christmas Red.

STEP 5: Wetbrush rocks Light Grey. Add washes of Mustard, Country Blue and Real Brown. Wetbrush rocks with Cream.

STEP 6: Apply Mask-It to Fired On Gold. Spray with Matte Spray. Remove Mask-It.

DH2488 SMALL DRAGON OF MIDDLE EARTH

MATERIALS AND COLORS NEEDED: DH04

True Red, DH08 Black, DH10 Mustard, DH20 Sky Blue, DH26 Lexington Green, DH29 White, DH30 Country Blue, DH36 Navy Blue, DH37 Cream, DH38 Grass Green, DH49 Premier Gold, SP02 Mask-It, SP05 Doc's Glue, SP08 Matte Spray, CG300 Clear Glaze, Fired On Gold, ultra fine glitter

STEP 1: Clean greenware and fire to cone 03. Apply three coats of Clear Glaze to belly, tips of wings and contments on globe. Fire to cone 05. Apply Fired On Gold to all glazed areas and fire to cone 018.

STEP 2: Basecoat dragon with Black. Wetbrush with Lexington Green and then with Grass Green. Highlight dragon with Mustard. Paint tongue True Red and eyes Mustard with Black pupils. Paint teeth Cream and toenails Premier Gold.

STEP 3: Basecoat water area of globe Country Blue. Highlight with Sky Blue. Shade water with Navy Blue. Basecoat clouds White. Apply Mask-It to gold areas and let dry. Spray with Matte Spray. Remove Mask-It. Brush Doc's glue over clouds and sprinkle with white ultra fine glitter.

DH2464 LARGE WIZARD & DH2465 TABLE WITH PLASMA BALL

MATERIALS AND COLORS NEEDED: DH03 True Orange, DH08 Black, DH09 Real Brown, DH12 Leather Brown, DH19 Light Grey, DH23 Bone, DH25 Toast, DH27 Midnight Blue, DH29 White, DH34 Soft Brown, DH40 Turquoise, DH45 Shadow Green, DH49 Premier Gold, DH52 Cranberry, AT01 Black, AT04 Red Brown, SP02 Mask-It, SP07 Krackle-It

STEP 1: Basecoat skin Soft Brown. Antique with Red Brown translucent. Basecoat beard and hair Light Grey. Antique with Black translucent. Paint eyes with Leaf Green iris, shaded with Shadow Green, Black pupils.

STEP 2: Wetbrush hair and beard with Light Grey. Highlight with Cream. Shade with a Black wash.

STEP 3: Basecoat trim on gown, seat back cushion, lower sleeves, background of shield with Turquoise. Shade these areas with a wash of Midnight Blue.

STEP 4: Basecoat all remaining areas Black.

STEP 5: Apply one coat Krackle-It on dragon's belly. Let dry. Apply one heavy coat of True Orange and let dry. Shade belly with a Cranberry wash. Wetbrush dragon's body and inner robe with Cranberry. Add a little Cream to same brush to lighten color and highlight dragon. Paint eyes Turquoise, shaded with Midnight Blue. Paint pupils Black and teeth Bone.

STEP 6: Wetbrush gown and robe with Midnight Blue. Lighten color with a little White and highlight.

STEP 7: Wetbrush wood with Real Brown. Highlight with Toast and Soft Brown.

STEP 8: Wetbrush chair sides Leather Brown. Paint star pattern on arms of chair. Paint sleeves, collar, belt and trim on gown and chair with Premier Gold.

STEP 9: Wetbrush rocks with Light Grey. Shade and tint them with washes of Toast, Midnight Blue,

Cranberry and Black. Wetbrush highlights on rocks with Cream.

STEP 10: Shade piece with Black to define detail.

STEP 11: Paint table with coordinating colors.

STEP 12: Apply Mask-It to Fired Gold areas. Spray with Matte Spray and remove Mask-It.

DH2500 MYSTICAL COBRA

MATERIALS AND COLORS NEEDED: DH08 Black, DH09 Real Brown, DH10 Mustard, DH27 Midnight Blue, DH34 Soft Brown, DH37 Cream, DH38 Grass Green, DH44 Blue Suede, AT01 Black

STEP 1: Basecoat belly of cobra with Cream. Basecoat the rest of cobra with Black.

STEP 2: Mix some Black into Real Brown to darken and paint markings on cobra's belly. Paint Black random markings on top of these dark areas. With a liner, paint faint "cracks" on belly skin.

STEP 3: Wetbrush remaining parts of cobra with Real Brown. Lighten bands across cobra's body with Medium Brown. Lighten them even more with Soft Brown. Tint the darker bands with a wash of Grass Green, followed by a very thin wash of Midnight Blue. Lighten head and flared area with Soft Brown. Tint these areas with Blue Suede, Grass Green and Real Brown.

STEP 4: Paint eyes Mustard with Black pupils. Paint a Black "spot" on each section of cobra's skin.

STEP 5: Antique entire cobra with Black translucent. Wipe away excess stain with a cloth dampened with solvent.

STEP 6: Spray heavily with gloss spray.
